## EURASTiP: Our Objective – and what is an NPP?



**Evaluate** the launch of an international multi-stakeholder platform for sustainable aquaculture – "EURopean ASian TiP"

The EU experience suggests international cooperation is best facilitated through a multidisciplinary and multi-stakeholder approach. There is consensus that this working methodology would be of benefit to se-Asian aquaculture."





"ASTiP"

• National NPPs (3)

- 70% of European seafood is imported, the majority (c. 65%) from SE Asia
- Aquaculture the only viable solution to meet rising consumer demands (c. 100%)
- SE Asia currently identified as key to satisfying the bulk of this demand
- At present c. 10% of entire se-Asian production is exported to the European market









Launched in 2017, EURASTiP is a €2 million, three year long support action developed in response to EU call H2020 SFS-24-2016 "reinforcing international cooperation on sustainable aquaculture production with countries from South East Asia"; building on 40 years of joint European / se-Asian research, development and collaboration.




# Platforms in Action
