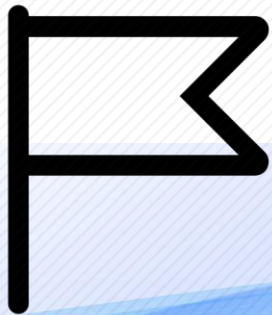

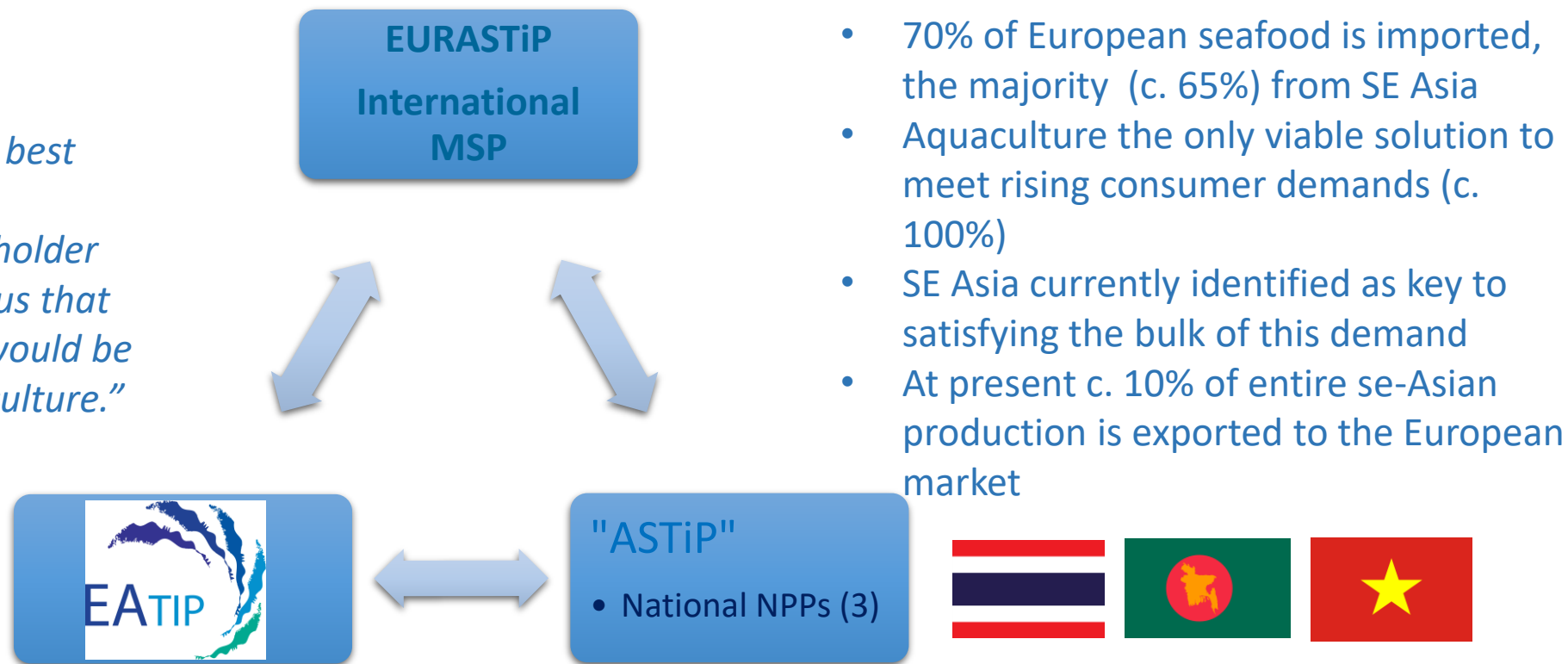

Launched in 2017, EURASTiP is a €2 million, three year long support action developed in response to EU call [H2020 SFS-24-2016](#) “reinforcing international cooperation on sustainable aquaculture production with countries from South East Asia” ; building on 40 years of joint European / se-Asian research, development and collaboration.
